

# **Excerpt from:**

St. Therese of Lisieux by those who knew her **Testimonies from the process of beatification** Edited and translated by Christopher O'Mahony. Published by Veritas Publications.

One day, when she was sorely troubled by an interior trial, she said: 'Oh, Mother, how fortunate for us that God became man, so that we could love him. It was well he did, for otherwise we would never have dared to love him.' Her approach to our Lord was chiefly through the Childhood and Passion. Her love of the child Jesus drew her to offer herself to him as a toy in the hands of a child. By this apparently childish expression, she meant that she should surrender herself entirely to our Lord's will, and be prepared to be treated by him as he pleased. In the Holy Face, she saw an xpression of all the humiliations our Lord had to endure, and drew from it a constant willingness to suffer and be umiliated for love of him. One day we were standing in front f a picture of the Holy Face, and I said: 'What a pity his eyes are lowered; we can't see the expression in them.' 'Oh, no!' she said. 'It's better that way; we could not look at his divine expression without dying of love." - Testimony of Mother Agnes of

#### **Calling ALL Catholics to Divine Mercy Sunday on April 23, 2017**
