Excerpt from: St. Therese of Lisieux by those who knew her Testimonies from the process of beatification Edited and translated by Christopher O'Mahony. Published by Veritas Publications.

"Before she entered Carmel, she told me that she wanted to be a Carmelite nun even if it was to save only one soul; a lifetime of suffering, she said would not be too much for that. But afterwards her desires embraced a lot more than that: her constant preoccupation was to win souls for God; she never stopped talking to me about it. When she was due for profession, she was asked, in accordance with the requirements of Canon Law, what her motives were for embracing this way of life. 'Above all,' she replied, 'it is to save souls and pray for priests.''' – Testimony of Mother Agnes of Jesus (Prioress of the Lisieux Carmel.)
