I want to fulfil your will perfectly and to attain to that degree of glory which you have prepared for me in your kingdom. In a word, I would dearly like to be holy, but I feel incapable of it; so I ask you, my God to be my holiness yourself....I am certain therefore that you will grant what I desire. I know, my God that when you want to give us more you increase our desires. My heart is full of immense desires, and I confidently invite you to come and take possession of it. I cannot receive holy communion as often as I would like to, Lord; but are you not all-powerful? Stay in me as you do in the tabernacle, and never leave this little host of yours." – Testimony of Mother Agnes of Jesus (Prioress of the Lisieux Carmel.)
