

If you are considering the Bible as a gift for Christmas, we suggest the NRSV (New Revised Standard Version) Catholic Edition. As the daily and Sunday Mass readings in English Canada are taken from this version. It is known to be reliable,

accurate and easy to read. Roman Catholic Bibles have 73 books (vs. Protestant Bibles which tend to have 66 books). A Roman Catholic Bible will also have an "Imprimatur" meaning it is free from doctrinal or moral error.


