"Towards the end of her life she was subjected to the terrible trial of being tempted to doubt the existence of heaven. She often confided her thoughts and impressions to me, but I cannot do better than to quote her own description of it. What she writes in her autobiography is exactly what she told me: 'I had such a vivid faith at the time that the thought of heaven filled me with happiness. I could not imagine that there were really some godless people who had no faith. I thought they were not being honest when they denied the existence of heaven. But during those joyful days of Eastertide Jesus made me see that there really are people who have not got this faith, people who lose this precious treasure by abusing His grace. He permitted my soul to be covered in thick darkness, and allowed the thought of heaven, which had always been so dear to me, to become something that caused me torment and internal conflict.
