St. Therese of Lisieux by those who knew her **Testimonies from the process of beatification**

"Sister Therese saw everything from the standpoint of faith; she never confined herself to the worldly or human side of events. When she had charge of the novices for instance, she never permitted them to criticise sermons or conferences. It was not that she thought all priests spoke equally well, but she could not bear for people to dwell on the shortcomings of their preaching. The same was true of the shortcomings of priests themselves: the spirit of faith did not allow these to be discussed, she said.

She went to confession for the first time when she was about six and a half years old. She regarded this as a great event in her life and very carefully examined her conscience before me. I had told her that the tears of the Child Jesus would fall on her soul and purify it at the moment of the priest's blessing, so she looked forward to it as if it were a great feast."—Testimony of Mother Agnes of Jesus (Therese's sister and prioress of the Lisieux Carmel.)

Catholic Corner

As Catholics, we are blessed to have traditions and sacramentals such as the brown scapular.



Wearing a Scapular

A scapular typically consists of 2 rectangular pieces of wool cloth with religious text or image on each side, connected by 2 strings. One piece rests on

your chest and the other drops down your back.

Origin of the Brown Scapular

The brown scapular is most likely the oldest of all the scapulars and has served as a model for all others. It was in 1251 that the Blessed Virgin Mary appeared to St. Simon Stock with a scapular in her hand and said, "Whoever dies in this garment, will not suffer everlasting fire. It is the sign of salvation, a safeguard in dangers, a pledge of peace and of the covenant." Mary also promised to grant special aid, especially at the hour of death, to all those who wear the scapular with fidelity and honor throughout life. Those who wish to become invested in the Confraternity of Mount Carmel need only have their scapular blessed by a priest and then wear it at all times to share in the indulgences and privileges.

Where to get a scapular

The St. Mark bookstall sells scapulars from \$2 to \$10.
