Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

It is Saturday night and I am still tidying up before turning my attention to packing for my vacation and flight to Ireland tomorrow night. This morning we celebrated the Feast of the Holy Name of Jesus and in the homily, I discussed the issue of how we often find ourselves faced with situations where those around us are taking His Holy Name without regard or disrespectfully to say the least. I wondered aloud how we might draw people's attention to this fact without appearing sanctimonious about it perhaps with humour or maybe with a close friend or relative in a serious solemn manner. One thing for sure. when we witness people caught in natural or man-made disasters, people are not using Jesus' name carelessly, nor so on their deathbed. After Mass, one parishioner shared about the first time he noticed his daughter doing so casually and with serious intent corrected her on this such that this young girl in school pointed it out to another child and who knows the ripple effect from there.
