Excerpt from: St. Therese of Lisieux by those who knew her Testimonies from the process of beatification Edited and translated by Christopher O'Mahony. Published by Veritas Publications.

"When Therese entered Carmel, I must admit there was a certain amount of laxity in the convent. Many nuns were, no doubt, quite observant, but there were not a few who were guilty of abuses. The Servant of God got on with her duty and took no notice of what others did. I have never seen her stop to hear the latest news from the groups that gathered round Mother Prioress outside the parlour, or

listen to uncharitable conversations. In our family troubles, she was much braver than the rest of us. After hearing painful news in the parlour, such as our father's state of health, she did not hang around to comfort herself by talking to us about it; she returned immediately to whatever she should have been doing in the community at the time."- Testimony of Mother Agnes of Jesus (Therese's sister and


