St. Therese of Lisieux by those who knew her **Testimonies from the process of beatification**

"When she entered Carmel, our Lord showed her that true wisdom consisted in desiring to be ignored. The day of her profession she carried a note next to her heart, saying: 'May nobody take any notice of me; may I be trodden underfoot like a grain of sand." During her 1892 retreat (she was then nineteen), she wrote me a note saying: 'How good it is to be hidden away and unknown even to people who are living with us! I have never wanted fame; contempt attracted me, but I found that even that brought me too much notice, and I longed to be forgotten.' The further she advanced in perfection, the humbler she became. There were still some little involuntary faults that she could not overcome, but she did not let this discourage her: 'I am resigned to being always imperfect.' she said, 'and I even find happiness in it.
