"She seemed to have a particular affection for those nuns that made her suffer, and she showed a preference for their company. Her eldest sister, Sister Marie of the Sacred Heart often expressed her surprise at this, and was sometimes hurt by it. 'I was a mother to her,' she once complained, 'and yet you'd think she loved that sister whom I can't stand better than she does me.' At recreation she never went out of her way to meet her own three sisters. She chatted with any nun, no matter who she was, and especially with anyone she felt was lonely or left out. Though naturally very sensitive and affectionate, she was very reserved in external signs of affection and her manner imposed a certain respect. During her last illness someone was trying to kill the flies that were pestering her, when Sister Therese made this rather surprising remark: 'They are the only enemies I have, and since God has told us to love our enemies I am glad they give me this opportunity to do so.
