"Almost all the nuns who have entered this convent since the Servant of God's death have done so because of her. The first to do so in these circumstances was Mother Marie-Ange of the Child Jesus. She took the Servant of God as her model and advanced very fervently along the way of spiritual childhood. She was entirely devoted to her Cause, and when she was prioress she succeeded in having it officially introduced. She offered up her life for its success and, after proving herself a worthy imitator of Sister Therese of the Child Jesus during her seven and a half years in religion, she died at the age of 28 with the most admirable sentiments of trust in the love for God. Prayers for Trinity Western University

On Sunday, November 26, will you pray for religious freedom in Canada?

The Facts:

- Trinity Western University was denied accreditation of its law school because the school requires students to sign a community covenant which includes a commitment to reserve sexual intimacy to the marriage of one man and one woman.
- This battle for accreditation has been played out across Canada with the Federation of the Law Societies of Canada affirming the accreditation, while three of its members dissented and said they would not accredit it.

Legal challenges have ensued in three provinces. The courts ruled in favour of TWU in two of the three cases. Two decisions were appealed to the Supreme Court of Canada, one for and one against TWU. Those two cases will be heard on November 30 and December 1 in Ottawa
