#### **Advent Wreath Tradition**

Decorating, baking, gift wrapping and parties...the Advent season can be a very joyous and yet stressful time. In the midst of our preparation, it is easy to miss the significance of the season. **Our Saviour's birth!!!** 

One way to anchor our Christmas celebration is the purchase or creation of an Advent Wreath. The Advent Wreath keeps us focused on the coming of Christ.

The wreath consists of 4 candles, 3 purple candles signifying penance and one rose candle signifying joy. The purple candle is lit the first, second and fourth week. On the third week, the pink candle is lit.

The light of the candles signifies the light of Christ. **Light the Advent Wreath Daily** 

One of the easiest ways to incorporate this tradition into your daily life is at meal time. The family/individual lights the appropriate candles and says a pray, perhaps the Advent Wreath Prayer for that week and have the candles remain burning during the meal.

The Advent Wreath is a beautiful reminder that **Jesus is the reason for the season!**
