St. Therese of Lisieux by those who knew her Testimonies from the process of beatification Edited and translated by Christopher O'Mahony. Published by Veritas Publications.

Sister Therese of the Child Jesus died on 30 September, 1897. She accepted her sufferings as a long-awaited grace. he did not ask for relief, except when obedience commanded it and then with great moderation: 'I ask for as little as possible,' she said one day. She would never pray that her pains would ease off; even in the midst of the most cruel ony all she would say was: 'God, you are so kind; please be erciful to me.' She had no fear of even the most intense pain hat she could expect; she just said: 'The pain may reach the mit, but if God has led me by the hand since childhood, I'm ure he's not going to abandon me now. The time may come when I am not able for any more, but I shall never have enough of it.' I am not saying she enjoyed her suffering or that she wanted to suffer more and more. This is how she described her dispositions: 'Are you not surprised at how I uffer, Mother? I am like a little child during my illness; my only thought is to acquiesce simply in what God wills: to uffer on from one minute to the next whatever he sends me, without worrying about the future. The only joy I find in eath is that it is God's will for me. I have no more desire to ie than I have to live. From a natural point of view, I would prefer death, but if I had a choice, I would not choose anything; I like only whatever God does.""
