Excerpt from: St. Therese of Lisieux by those who knew her Testimonies from the process of beatification Edited and translated by Christopher O'Mahony. Published by Veritas Publications.

'Because of her temptation to disbelieve in heaven, her soul remained plunged in the darkest night till the very end. When confiding this painful experience to me, she said: 'Must one

have such thoughts when one loves God so much?' The following note, written on 3 August, sums up her sentiments in the face of physical and moral suffering: 'O God, how good you are to the little victim of Merciful Love! Even now, when you have added physical pain to my spiritual trials, I still

cannot say: 'The anguish of death is all around me' (PS 17:5). Mine is a cry of gratitude: 'I have gone down into the valley of the shadow of death, but I fear no evil, Lord, for you are
