

St. Therese of Lisieux by those who knew her Testimonies from the process of beatification

"She always hoped to die of love; she was even certain she would: 'I always hope to die of love,' she told us. 'To die of love does not of course mean to die rapturously: our Lord died of love on the Cross, and look at the agony he endured.' Another day she said to me: 'I am not looking forward to enjoyment and rest in heaven; all that attracts me is love: to love, to be loved and to return to the world to make God loved, to help missionaries, priests and the whole Church. I want to spend my heaven doing good on earth.' To my mind, the qualities that stood out most during her last illness were simplicity, distrust of herself, humility, constant recourse to prayer, and trust in God."
