"She made her first holy communion at the Benedictine Abbey on 8 May, 1884. I was already in Carmel at the time, and it was chiefly Marie who prepared her for this. Three months before her first communion, I gave her a little notebook in which she was to write down every evening her sacrifices and little acts of love for Jesus. Her total for the three months was: 818 sacrifices and 2,773 acts of love or aspirations." – Testimony of Mother Agnes of Jesus (Therese's elder sister and future prioress of the Lisieux Carmel.)
