"Our parents were looked upon as religious, even very devout, people. In spite of her hard-working life, mother both went to holy communion four or five times a week. Towards the end of his life father became a daily communicant; he was also a member of the St. Vincent de Paul Society, the nocturnal adoration sodality, etc. Both observed the Lenten fast and abstinence, despite mother's delicate health. Father observed Sunday rest strictly, even

though closing his shop on that day was particularly damaging to his business." – Testimony of Mother Agnes of Jesus (Therese's elder sister and future prioress of the Lisieux Carmel.)


