



FAMILY OF FAITH CAMPAIGN



Amount pledged to date: \$228,020 Why are we having this campaign?

1. We desperately need to expand our church. The basic truth is we've outgrown our premises. The population of Whitchurch-Stouffville has skyrocketed. As of the last census (2011), we were the second fastest growing city in all of Canada. Our Catholic population is growing accordingly. We can seat 300: we need to be able to seat 600.



2. The new French Catholic School has just opened and a new Catholic high school is coming in 2019. This will bring with even more pressure to bear on our parish. We need to plan ahead.



3. Look at the growth in our groups. We have a flourishing Youth Ministry, a growing Women's Ministry, the Squires, the Knights of Columbus, to name only a few. We simply don't have enough meeting space for these groups that are so vital to the spiritual life of our parish.



4. Our **parish hall** does not meet modern accessibility requirements. Very soon we will be forced to comply.



5. The Archdiocese of Toronto is conducting a Family of Faith campaign over the entire Archdiocese. Every parish is participating. To avoid running two fundraising campaigns, we have chosen to combine our share of the Family of Faith contribution with our expansion plans. We have already received a share of the Family of Faith funds in the form of a \$50,000 contribution to our Youth Ministry.
