
PASTORAL REFERENCE LETTERS FOR SCHOOL

St. Therese of Lisieux by those who knew her Testimonies from the process of beatification Edited and translated by Christopher O'Mahony.

"At the age of ten and a half, Therese was struck down by a strange illness. It consisted of attacks of terror, with horrible visions and an urge to throw herself head-first off the bed. She said afterwards that she never lost the use of her reason for one moment, and that when she seemed to be unconscious she

actually heard and understood everything that was being said around her. She was always convinced, too, that the devil had

a lot to do with these phenomena. The illness disappeared suddenly on 10 May, 1883, and never troubled her again. The circumstances attending this sudden end were as follows: during a novena we were making to Our Lady of Victories, she had a more violent attack than usual. Those of my sisters who were present started to pray to the Blessed Virgin before a statue in the room. In spite of the attack, Therese joined in invoking Mary's help. She told me that she suddenly saw the

statue come to life, and that the Blessed Virgin moved towards her, smiling. From that moment there was no further trace of her illness." Testimony of Mother Agnes of Jesus

Our parishioners have the option to give their offertory donations via the Pre-Authorized Giving (PAG) program. With PAG your offering is deducted automatically by direct debit from your bank account on a monthly basis. PAG allows you to support your parish when you are away—a benefit to the church, since expenses continue all year long. PAG only applies to offertory; other special collections and the Building Fund are not part of the PAG program. You are encouraged to use numbered offertory envelopes even if you use PAG. You may continue to place your Sunday envelope in the offertory basket—simply write "PAG" on the front. We currently have 64 parishioners using this method.

How to register for the Pre-Authorized Giving Program

PAG pamphlets are available in the church foyer. Enrolment is ongoing.

Simply fill in the tear off registration portion of the pamphlet, attach a void cheque and submit to the parish office or place in an envelope marked 'PAG Confidential' and place in the weekly collection basket.
