

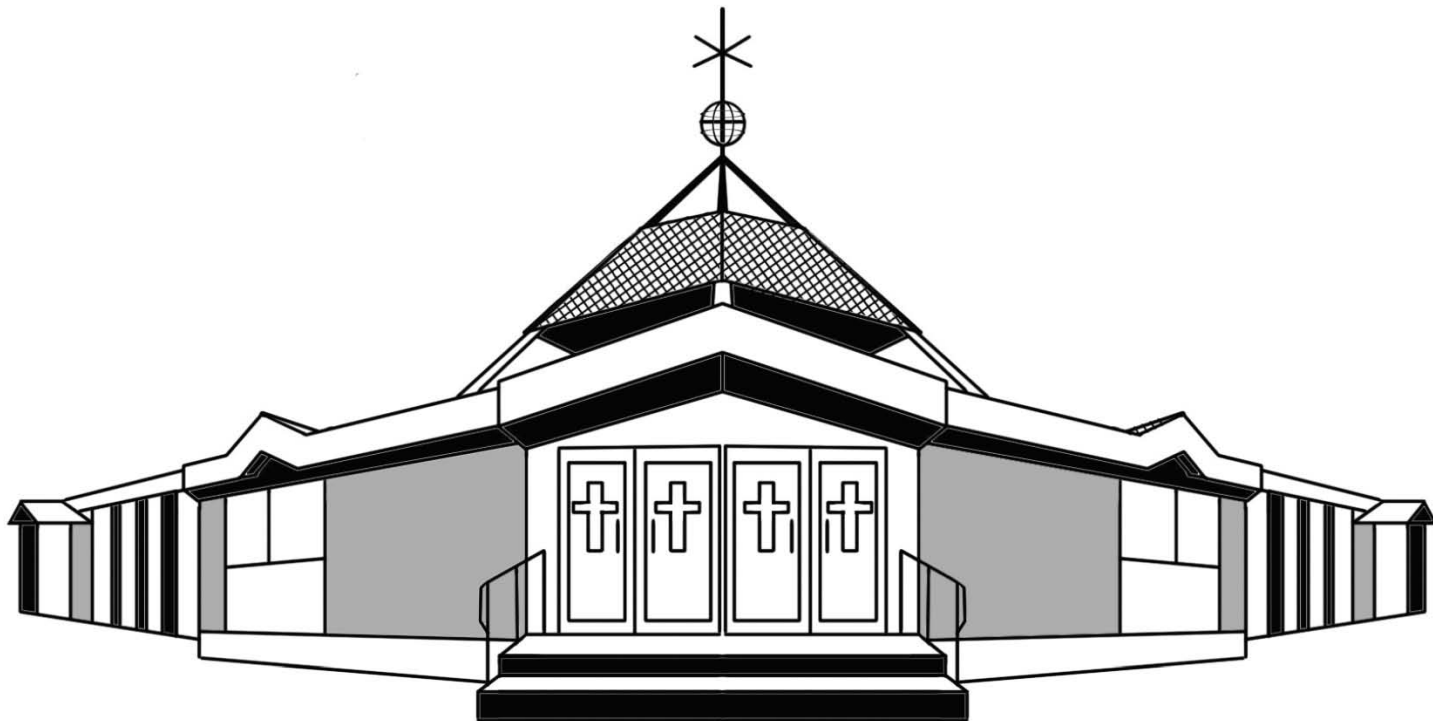

ELECTRONIC FUND TRANSFER
