

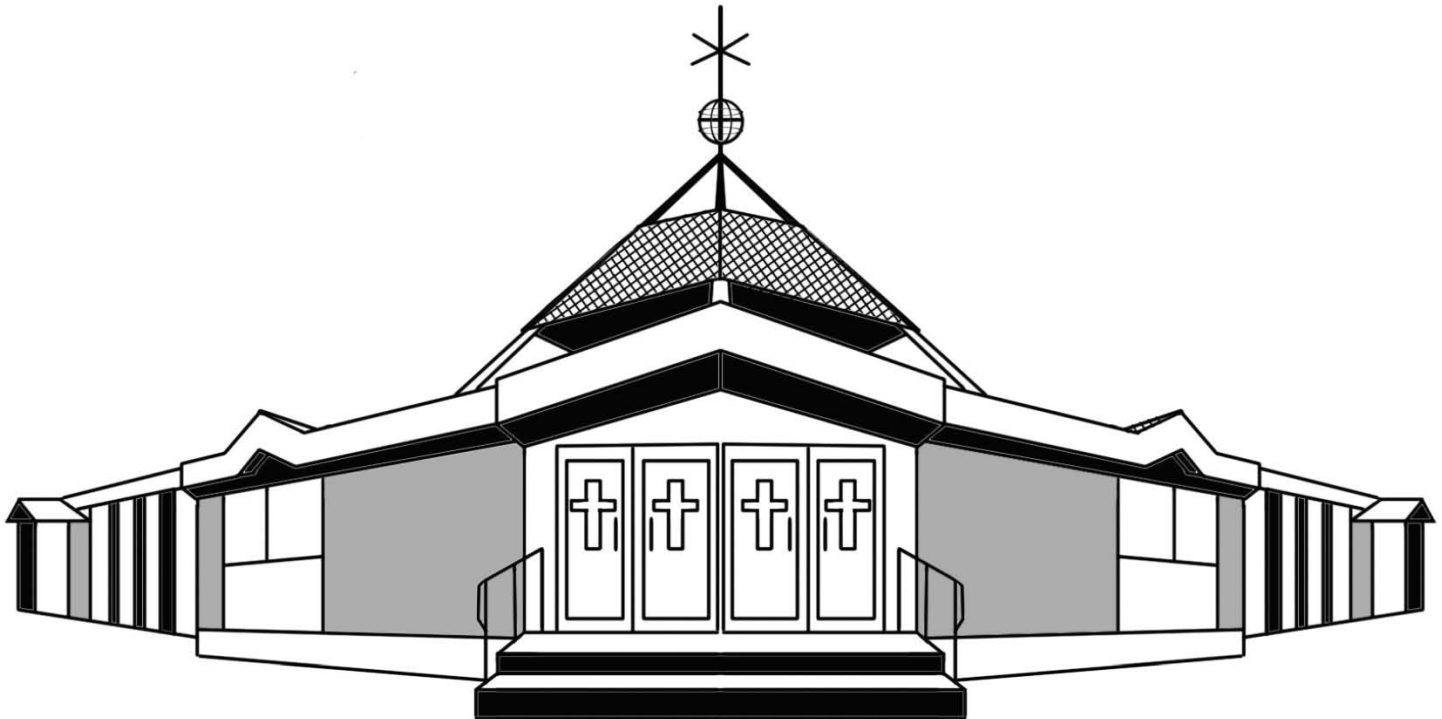

ELECTRONIC FUND TRANSFER

The 2025 envelopes are in the process of being issued. **Before they are ready for distribution, please consider using our PRE-AUTHORIZED GIVING PLAN** (Electronic Fund Transfer) for supporting the church instead of using the box of envelopes.

 - enabling your support to the parish to be continued, allowing the parish's reoccurring maintenance expenses to be paid, even if you are not present on the weekend
 - Minimizing the amount of cash that has to be handled by the Collection Counting Ministry

Called to Witness and Proclaim: A Pastoral Letter on Evangelization and Catechesis in the Family -

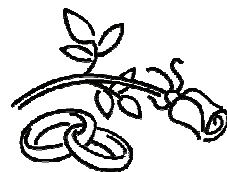
