Ontario Beast Screening Program Expansion

In October 2024, the Ontario Breast Screening Program (OBSP) lowered the starting age for screening from age 50 to age 40. The OBSP encourages people ages 40 to 49 to make an informed decision about whether to get screened for breast cancer by talking with their doctor, nurse practitioner, or a Health 811 navigator. 
