Marriage - Weddings for parishioners are generally celebrated on Saturday afternoons. Kindly contact the Pastor a minimum of one year before the desired date of marriage. Preparation is provided in the Parish.

Arrangements can be made for the *Sacrament of the Sick* and for *Holy Communion*. November is Fall Prevention Awareness Month

Together we can raise the profile of fall prevention and encourage everyone to see their role in preventing falls and fall-related injuries across the lifespan. Falling is a typical part of development as children walk, climb, run, jump, play and explore their environment. Most of these falls don't cause serious injury, however, falls are the leading cause of hospital admissions from injury in those ages 0 to 14. Our bodies naturally change with age and can affect the way we feel, move, and behave. Falls are the leading cause of injury-related hospitalizations among older adults; 20-30% of older adults fall each year. Strategies to prevent falls for older adults: exercises that challenge balance and build strength, don't rush when walking or getting up, have sight and hearing checked regularly, review your medications regularly with your pharmacist or doctor, wear well-fitting sturdy shoes, use a cane or mobility device if needed, and keep stairs free of clutter. 
