

World Day of Prayer for Vocations



Dear Parishioners:

Today is the 55th World Day of Prayer for Vocations. In this year's message, Pope Francis speaks about the upcoming Synod of Bishops in October that will meet to discuss the theme of young people and in particular the relationship between young people, faith and vocation.

The Holy Father reminds us about three aspects of any vocation that were also present at the time of Jesus' own mission: listening, discerning and living. Listening - God comes to us quietly and discreetly, without imposing on our freedom. We need to rise above the noise around us in order to listen carefully to God's voice through His Word. Discerning - each of us can discover our own vocation through spiritual discernment. Discernment involves dialogue with the Lord, reading the signs of the times and responding to God's invitation. Living - means to engage our lives with the world around us in a way that makes the Gospel come alive.

Let us pray that our young people may actively discern, discover and respond to the Lord's invitation to serve Him and the people to whom the Lord sends them. We also pray in a special way for our twenty young people from our community who will be Confirmed today. May they continue to grow in their faith and discern the Lord's will in their lives.
