



Papal Blessings

Dear Parishioners:

A Papal Blessing is a very meaningful way to commemorate a very special occasion in yours or your loved one's life.

While the blessing itself is invisible to the eye, it can be memorialized in a unique hand painted parchment certificate inscribed with the name(s) of the recipients, featuring the papal seal and the current Pope's photo. Parishioners may order a Papal Blessing scroll to commemorate a milestone wedding anniversary or birthday, as well as the reception of the sacrament of baptism, first communion, confirmation, marriage, and religious ordination and profession.

A Papal Blessing can only be issued to a practicing baptized Catholic and a member of our parish. The Papal Blessing itself is free, but there is a cost of \$50 to cover expenses and shipment.

Until now the Parish has not asked for any offering. In almost all the parishes of the Diocese and other Dioceses, the individual requesting the Papal Blessing covers the entire cost.

Since there has been an increase in requests and because the cost has gradually increased, we will ask a minimum offering of \$30 from registered Parishioners and \$50 from non-registered Parishioners to help process your application for a Papal Blessing through the Papal Nunciature in Ottawa.

I want to encourage you to commemorate your special occasions for yourself and loved ones through a Papal Blessing and I appreciate your willingness to help the Parish in that regard.


