

Re-Opening of Church: Welcome Back! After a little more than three months we thank God for the opportunity to gather once again. As you will see with our new signage, we ask that you monitor your own health, stay home if you have any flu like symptoms, sore throat, cold, fever, etc. If you feel you are high risk, stay home. If you feel more comfortable with less people, then attend weekday Mass. Masks are mandatory, except when you are about to approach Fr. Peter or the minister to receive the Communion host on the hand only. For seating, pews have been blocked off. We can sit three individuals, spaced properly, or a single family. Sanitize your hands as you enter. Please enter with proper distancing of more than six feet – both outside and inside of the church. Use the bathroom out of necessity - one person or family at a time. We have trained our new health and safety volunteers to assist you - the ones wearing the safety vests. Please listen to their instructions. They must be followed with no questions. Thank you for your patience and cooperation.

**First Communion Celebrations:** Beginning this weekend and for the next several weekends we will be celebrating the First Communion of the children who are to receive the Sacrament this year. We ask that the children and family be at Church at least 15 minutes prior to the celebration.

#### The Message of Our Lady of Fatima

Dear Parishioners:

A new movie about Our Lady of Fatima and the three visionary children called Fatima will premier on August 28, 2020. There will be limited viewing in theatres across Canada and the United States due to the pandemic. It can also be accessed on premium video on demand - Apple itunes and Amazon Prime for Part historical drama and part virtual pilgrimage the movie is already receiving notoriety. Unlike most religious productions that feature unknown actors, the cast of Fatima includes well known actors with international fame, such as Harvey Keitel who plays the skeptical Professor Nichols. In the movie the professor interviews that last surviving visionary in her later years, Sr. Lucia played by the Brazilian international star, Sonia Braga. The Professor tries to arrive at the historical truth of what happened on the hillside. All she can relay are the sequence of events but not what they mean. The Professor remains in a state of doubt at the end of the movie while Sr. Lucia stands by her firm belief and conviction that there is a bridge to Heaven.

The movie has been described as a historical drama, a virtual pilgrimage and a homage to Our Lady of Fatima. One can remain skeptical whether the children and the thousands gathered that fateful day on October 17, 1917, witnessed the so-called "miracle of the sun." Our Lady wanted to give us a visible sign of her apparitions.

The movie does not prove or settle the debate but affirms once again that the message of Fatima of conversion and repentance and the belief in life everlasting will come down to the individual and his or her willingness to believe. True faith cannot be proven by empirical evidence. Either one believes or not. Since 1930 the Church has declared the apparitions of Our Lady of Fatima as "worth of belief." One is not required to believe as a dogma of faith, but ultimately Our Lady speaks about the Gospel values that have been with us since the time of her beloved Son, Jesus Christ.
