

PARISH NEWS

Church Capacity: As of July 15, the Province has entered Step 3. We are now allowed 30% capacity in church. That means approximately 100 people for Blessed Sacrament and 60 people for St. Anthony Daniel. Those who wish to receive Communion on the tongue now can. Receive at the end of the line. Thank you for your patience and understanding.

First Holy Communion: We are rescheduling First Holy Communion to early fall of this year. More details will be provided to parents in the near future. Thank you for your patience.

Please continue to give: We appreciate the generosity of the parishioners during the lockdown. If you were unable to give your weekly contribution during the lockdown, please consider giving extra so that we can meet our week to week expenses. Thank you!

Migrant Farmworkers: As our migrant workers begin to arrive, please keep them in your prayers. We pray for their safety and wellbeing and are grateful to their employers who do all they can to create a safe work environment. Our outreach will continue throughout the season. Thank you for your continuing generosity.

Sick Calls: For the time being, only the Priest on call for a particular week can visit the sick in our local hospital. However, please let the office know if you or your loved one is sick. We will pray for them.

Marriage Support - Is your marriage experiencing more trouble than joy, feeling stagnant or disconnected and/or causing you worries? The solution is Retrouvaille - a program for married couples facing difficult challenges in their relationship. Retrouvaille has one purpose: to help couples restore their marriage and rebuild a loving partnership. This is a practical program, where sharing is not required except between couple themselves, designed to improve the communication, build stronger marriages, and help couples reconnect. It also works well for couples who may be considering separation or divorce. Retrouvaille is offering their weekends by zoom offering more possibilities for engagement.


