

Re-Opening of Church: Welcome Back! After a little more than three months we thank God for the opportunity to gather once again. As you will see with our new signage, we ask that you monitor your own health, stay home if you have any flu like symptoms, sore throat, cold, fever, etc. If you feel you are high risk, stay home. If you feel more comfortable with less people, then attend weekday Mass. Masks are mandatory, except when you are about to approach Fr. Peter or the minister to receive the Communion host on the hand only. For seating, pews have been blocked off. We can sit three individuals, spaced properly, or a single family. Sanitize your hands as you enter. Please enter with proper distancing of more than six feet – both outside and inside of the church. Use the bathroom out of necessity – one person or family at a time. We have trained our new health and safety volunteers to assist you - the ones wearing the safety vests. Please listen to their instructions. They must be followed with no questions. Thank you for your patience and cooperation.

Decoration Sunday: Sunday, August 9 at 2:00 p.m. at the Burford Pioneer Cemetery by the Columbarium. Because of COVID-19, we will have a short service with no reception afterward.

First Communion Celebrations: We will be reaching out to the parents of the children who were to receive First Holy Communion last May. We will do our best to re-schedule the celebrations in the coming weeks. Our new Assistant Secretary, Michela Gabriele, will be scheduling the celebrations beginning August 22.

Funeral Mass: We are allowed up to 30% capacity in church for a funeral Mass. These are the guidelines as mandated by the Province of Ontario. If a family had a funeral during the lockdown and would like to schedule a Mass in Church, please contact the Parish Office.

Venerable Fr. Michael J. McGivney

Dear Parishioners:

On May 27 the Vatican announced that **Father Michael McGivney**, the founder of the **Knights of Columbus**, will be beatified during a special Mass Oct. 31 at the Cathedral of St. Joseph in Hartford. Pope Francis, who met with the board of directors of the Knights of Columbus in February, had signed the decree recognizing a miracle through the intercession of Father McGivney, clearing the way for his beatification. Once he is beatified, he will be given the title "Blessed."

The miracle recognized by the Vatican occurred in 2015 and involved a U.S. baby, still in utero, with a lifethreatening condition that, under most circumstances, could have led to an abortion. That baby, Mikey Schachle, is now 5. His parents, Dan and Michelle Schachle, of Dickson, Tennessee, prayed to Father McGivney to intercede with God to save their son, still in his mother's womb, who was given no hope of surviving a life-threatening of fetal hydrops. case Father McGivney (1852-1890), the son of Irish immigrants, was born in Waterbury, Connecticut, and was ordained a priest in 1877 for what is now the Archdiocese of Hartford. He founded the Knights of Columbus at St. Mary's Parish in New Haven, Connecticut, in 1882. He originally started the Knights as a service organization to help widows and orphans. At the time, Father McGivney was an assistant pastor at St. Mary's Parish. He is buried in New Haven.

The fraternal order for Catholic men has become the largest lay Catholic organization in the world with 2 million members and sponsors a wide range of educational, charitable and religious activities. "Father McGivney has inspired generations of Catholic men to roll up their sleeves and put their faith into action," Supreme Knight Carl A. Anderson said. "He was decades ahead of his time in giving the laity an important role within the church. Today, his spirit continues to shape the extraordinary charitable work of Knights as they continue to serve those on the margins of society as he served widows and orphans in the 1880s." He added, "Father McGivney also remains an important role model for parish priests around the world and left us a transformative legacy of effective cooperation between the laity and clergy."
