Parish News...



Sunday, December 25 No Mass

Christmas Eve is filled with anticipation and distractions. A simple prayer before bed can be a nice way to close the day, refocus on the birth of Jesus and connect the day that's passed with the big upcoming celebrations in the morning.

The Christmas Eve prayer attributed to Robert Louis Stevenson, a Scottish poet and author from the 19th century reads below:

A Christmas Eve Prayer

Loving Father,

Help us remember the birth of Jesus, that we may share in the song of the angels, the gladness of the shepherds, and worship of the wise men. Close the door of hate and open the door of love all over the world. Let kindness come with every gift and good desires with every greeting. Deliver us from evil by the blessing which Christ brings, and teach us to be merry with clear hearts. May the Christmas morning make us happy to be thy children. and Christmas evening bring us to our beds with grateful thoughts, forgiving and forgiven, for Jesus' sake.

Amen.

- "Praying for you on this wonderful Christmas day!"
- Connecting with others who may not celebrate Christmas
 - "Thinking of you and hoping your day is filled with love and peace"
 - "Best wishes to you and all of your loved ones on this special day"
