

Parenting Tip

For Catholics, Christmas is about so much more than gifts: it is the promise, through the birth of Jesus, of goodness and light coming into our lives. Do your children know this is the focus of Christmas? Advent and Christmas are perfect times to highlight the "reason for the season". Read stories about the Advent wreath so they understand what each candle symbolizes; read the story of the Nativity (more than

once!); be sure the tree is adorned with symbols of the faith; read family Advent reflections daily during Advent; attend Mass and reflect on the readings each week, including Christmas Day. Faith sets a foundation on which to stand and Christmas is a perfect time to bring Christ into your family activities!

Throughout the Advent season the readings will encourage us to focus on what is really important leading up to the weeks prior to Christmas. For example, in today's liturgy both Isaiah and John the Baptist remind us that this season of Advent is about preparing the way for the Lord. For some of us, that might mean committing more time for prayer each day, even in the midst of the busyness of this month.
