

Shalom alecheim! The Hebrew expression for Peace upon you! Allow me to share with you some thoughts as we continue the Holy Land Pilgrimage.

As I write this message, we have passed the midpoint of the Pilgrimage. We began in the Galilee region focusing on the areas where Jesus initiated his public ministry, such as Nazareth, Cana, Capernaum, the River Jordan and the Sea of Galilee.
