

### FILM FESTIVAL: Join the Reel Justice Film Festival

February 23, 2023 7:00 PM - 9:00 PM for a film screening featuring two short films that highlight challenges and approaches to affordable housing. A Better Tent City follows a group of dedicated individuals, including those living rough, service providers, community members and municipal staff, working together to create a self-organized housing community in Kitchener, ON. Safe explores the housing and opioid crises through the stories of tenants that live in Indwell affordable housing units, available for people experiencing poverty because of their mental health and/or substance use disorders, in Hamilton, London, Woodstock, Simcoe and Mississauga. Both films focus on the necessity for low barrier housing, community building, and respect for our shared home. Special discussion following the screening with Fr. Toby Collins, C.R., Pastor at St. Mary, Kitchener speaking about his work and ministry with Tiny Homes and A Better Tent City, as well as with Jess Brand, Indwell regional manager for Hamilton discussing the community engagement, programs, and initiatives offered through Indwell to provide supportive affordable housing. Blessed Saint Joseph, holy guardian of Jesus and Mary, assist ús by your prayers in all the necessities of life.



### **Saint Peter Damian**

### **February 21**

Italian **San Pietro Damiani**, (born

1007, Ravenna, Italy—died February 22, 1072. Feast day February 21. Cardinal and Doctor of the Church, an original leader and a forceful figure in the Gregorian Reform movement, whose personal example and many writings exercised great influence on religious life in the 11th and 12th centuries.



### **Saint Polycarp**

### **February 23**

Polycarp had been a Christian since he was a child, but the Romans didn't get around to killing him until he was in his eighties. Whatever the reason for the delay, it is still the first recorded martyrdom in post-New Testament church history. St. Polycarp was a Christian bishop of Smyrna.<sup>[2]</sup> According to the *Martyrdom of Polycarp*, he died a martyr, bound and burned at the stake, then stabbed when the fire failed to consume his body. Polycarp is regarded as a saint and Church Father in the Catholic, Eastern Orthodox, Oriental Orthodox, Anglican, and Lutheran churches. Polycarp is regarded as one of three chiefs of the Apostolic Fathers.
