

Dear Parishioners:

This month the Catholic Bishops of Ontario are asking all parishioners to add their email addresses to a list so that they can receive a link to material on the Coalition for HealthCARE and Conscience web site. Our sign up list is at the back of the Church.

The Bishops are working in conjunction with this Coalition to pressure our provincial election candidates to respect conscience rights for doctors and faith-based health care institutions when it comes to assisted suicide.

Presently Catholic hospital CEOs say they have a right to opt out of assisted dying, but one can foresee the day when it will be tested in the courts and legislature. We cannot sit on the sidelines. We need to hold the fire to the feet of our politicians and demand a clear position with the upcoming Provincial election in June.

To quote Irish political philosopher Edmund Burke: "Evil triumphs when good men do nothing." Let us join our voices and concerns with other faith organizations in upholding the gift and culture of life.
