

If circumstances permit, we hope to re-schedule for the month of April. Candidates and parents have been notified. Also, please return all the required forms to the office as soon as possible.

**Daily Mass:** During the lockdown Fr. Peter will offer daily private Mass for your intentions. On Sunday he will offer Mass for all parishioners (living and deceased). Let us pray for better days ahead in 2021!

#### Dear Parishioners:

Last week, His Excellency, Douglas Crosby, Bishop of the Diocese of Hamilton, issued a pastoral letter, *For the Common Good: On the Pandemic Sacrifices*. The letter has been posted on the Diocese of Hamilton web site or you can contact the Parish office for an electronic or print copy. I would like to highlight the salient pointes raised by Bishop Crosby:

The decision to close our churches has been a painful one for everyone: the Bishop, Priests, Deacons, Religious and Laity. Certainly it is a sacrifice to not have our regular celebration of Holy Eucharist as we normally do, but we must make the sacrifice.

The Eucharist is the source and summit of our Christian life. When we partake of the Eucharist we share in the Body and Blood of Christ and "we become what we eat."

During the pandemic we unite ourselves closely to Christ by making the necessary health sacrifices for the health and well-being of others, especially the elderly and the vulnerable. Sacrifices are never easy, but there is an invaluable lesson to be learned for all, especially our children. Sometimes we have to give up our freedom and privileges for the care of others.

The Bishop reminds us that there are many places around the world, including the Diocese where he served in Corner Brook, NL, whereby the Eucharist is celebrated monthly or even a few times a year. Yet the people are resilient in their faith and learn to nurture a deeply spiritual relationship to the Lord.

Since the Government of Ontario mandated a general wide lockdown across the Province, the Bishop has mandated that all churches be closed. Nevertheless, we unite ourselves spiritually with our Priests who continue to offer the sacrifice of the Mass daily on our behalf.

Let us continue to pray for one another, especially for those who are suffering the most during the Pandemic. Let us pray for the effective distribution of the vaccine so that we can gather again soon and give thanks to the Lord through our Eucharistic gathering.
