

## VACATION BIBLE SCHOOL 2018

Dear Parishioners:

This week will mark an exciting time for the life of the Parish: Vacation Bible School or Camp for children between the ages of 5-12. A number of other churches in the area have offered this program year to year, but it is wonderful to see that we will be offering a Catholic summer program.
