

THE WARPED THINKING OF THE CULTURE OF DEATH

The fate of little baby Charlie Gard in Great Britain has captured the attention of the world. Baby Charlie was born 11 months ago with a rare genetic disease. He is on life support and the London hospital treating him has petitioned the courts to have Charlie removed from life support, in other words, to end his life.

Charlie's parents, Chris Gard and Connie Yates, have been waging a long and wrenching legal battle to keep him alive.

Facing such a life and death issue is so devastating for any family member, and all the more painful for the parents of an infant.

We now see what St. John Paul II prognosticated over 20 years ago when he wrote about a society that loses its way even to the point of advocating the culture of death over the culture of life. A society that allows for doctor-assisted suicide will have no qualms about allowing a "death panel" to make the ultimate decision of life and death, even against the wishes of parents and loved ones. Doctors in the United States and Italy - at the behest of Pope Francis - have offered to give Charlie a fighting chance. Sadly, the British medical and legal intelligentsia have given up on baby Charlie by forbidding his parents to transfer him outside of the country for alternative treatment. Charlie has so far lived well beyond the three months the doctors originally predicted he would survive. Let us hope and pray that time will not run out before it is too late.
