

PARISH NEWS

Church capacity: As of June 30, the Province has entered Step 2. We are now allowed 25% capacity in church. That means approximately 80 people for Blessed Sacrament and 45 people for St. Anthony Daniel. You are no longer required to pre-register for any of the weekend Masses.
