



# Psalm 23: The Lord is My Shepherd

Dear Parishioners:

In today's reading we hear the refrain from the Responsorial Psalm (Psalm 23): "The Lord is my shepherd, I shall not want." We often hear this Psalm sung at funerals or recited during the funeral prayer vigil. For many of us who have lost loved ones, it is comforting to hear how the Lord will shepherd our deceased loved ones "through the darkest valley..." and allow them to dwell with Him forever.

Yet the Psalm prayer speaks to all of us, the living and the deceased alike. Psalm 23 speaks loudly of God's fidelity and loving protection. The Psalm and the Gospel for today also remind us that the Lord will provide rest for our weary souls. We will truly lack for nothing if we place our trust in the Lord. During moments of weariness and desperation, God leads and nourishes us by still waters in our innermost being. It may take us some time to discover and trust this.
