

MARRIAGE TIP

Compliment and criticism: two words, each with a lot of power. The first word is positive, the second one destructive. Keep track for a couple of days of the number of times you do both. If the balance is in favour of compliments, good; if not, you may need to change your communication style. Research has shown that chronic criticism in a relationship is the number one reason for break-ups. Try going on a no-criticism diet for a day and see how much calmer and happier your relationship can be.

PARENTING TIP

The art of discipline can be very complicated, but how we view discipline can have a profound impact. Discipline should not be seen as tool to be used only after a problem, but it should be used as a tool to prevent a problem. Children of all ages need to hear clear and exact expectations of their behaviour and the consequence if they do not behave in this manner. The child is then armed with the tools for success. Following through with a consequence is important, but helping prevent the poor behaviour in the first place is even better.

CULTURE OF LIFE AND HOPE

Dear Parishioners:

Last week I addressed the life and death decision facing baby Charlie Gard of Great Britain. His parents want access to extraordinary measures that may save his life while the hospital is seeking to remove Charlie from life support – against the wishes of the parents. The courts have given Charlie a small chance at life by allowing physicians from the United States to examine Charlie and determine if a new experimental procedure can save his life.

What bewilders me in all this is – with all the extraordinary advances in medicine, why are the so-called experts so entrenched in preventing Charlie a fighting chance to live? I do not pretend to know the answer but it does underline for me the enduring truth that advances in science and medicine always require ongoing dialogue, ethical wisdom and insight. Science and medicine alone cannot answer the deeper, moral conundrum at stake here.

I recall a few years ago I was asked to baptize a newborn infant on life support. The doctors were certain that the infant born with an under-developed brain had at best a few days of life. It was a very emotional and heart-wrenching celebration of the Sacrament. I told the parents to call me as soon as the inevitable occurred to make arrangements for their child's funeral and burial. I'm happy to say that to this day the call was never made. In fact the child is now approaching his second birthday as he overcomes his health challenges each day.

I do not know if baby Charlie will ever reach his second birthday, and there are times when death is inevitable. Nevertheless, science and medicine are fallible and before the great mystery of life, we must humbly concede we do not always have the complete truth, especially when life hangs in a balance. May Charlie's fight for life continue and give his parents the possibility of hope for a better outcome.
