Re-Opening of Church: Welcome Back! After a little more than three months we thank God for the opportunity to gather once again. As you will see with our new signage, we ask that you monitor your own health, stay home if you have any flu like symptoms, sore throat, cold, fever, etc. If you feel you are high risk, stay home. If you feel more comfortable with less people, then attend weekday Mass. We strongly urge you to wear a mask at all times, except when you are about to approach Fr. Peter or the minister to **receive the Communion host on the hand only**. For seating, pews have been blocked off. We can sit three individuals, spaced properly, or a single family. Sanitize your hands as you enter. Please enter with proper distancing of more than six feet – both outside and inside of the church. Use the bathroom out of necessity – one person or family at a time. We have trained our new health and safety volunteers to assist you – **the ones wearing the safety vests**. Please listen to their instructions. They must be followed with no questions. Thank you for your patience and cooperation.

Mass on TV/Web: For those unable to attend, you can watch the Mass at home. Vision TV: Sunday at 8 am; Monday to Friday, 8 am and 12 noon. Saturday, 8:00 am and 9:30 am. Salt & Light: Monday – Saturday, 6:30 am and 9:30 am with the Pope. 11:00 am, 3:00 pm and 10:30 pm; Sunday 10:00 am and 11:30 pm. CHTV at 1:00 pm. You can also see the Mass anytime on the internet.

Blessing with the St. Anne Relic: The weekend of July 25-26, we will have special prayers for healing and invoke the intercession of St. Anne. Fr. Peter will bless the parishioners with a special relic of St. Anne at the end of Mass, a relic which has documented healings and special blessings. This year Fr. Mike Isabelle cannot join us, but he has graciously offered to allow us to use the relic this year.

Unless the grain of wheat dies...



Dear Parishioners:

I cannot thank you enough for your generosity and care for our migrant Farmworkers during this difficult health crisis of the pandemic. It has been quite an experience these past few weeks.

All the workers were very appreciative of your kindness and generosity. They all asked me to convey their profound gratitude.

Sadly we lost one worker, Juan Lopez Chaparro. He leaves behind a wife, Agostina and four children. Juan came to work at Scotlyn Farm with his nephew, Almador Antonio Alcantara. Juan was described as a good man, husband and father, and a hard worker. When I had to convey the news to Almador and his companions, it broke my heart. I can't imagine the loss for the family. But as I have been saying publicly, it is a loss for all of us. There will be time to question and probe the causes and how to avoid future spread and potential tragedy for the different groups of men who live and work in close proximity to one another.

We have heard from the Prime Minister and the Premier, migrant workers are essential workers. Yes, they are vital for our farming industry. But they too deserve the care and protection extended to all our frontline workers.

During our moving memorial Mass for Juan we sang a song that references John 12:24, "Unless the grain of wheat falls to the ground and dies, it remains just a grain of wheat; but if it dies, it produces much fruit." Let us hope and pray that the death of Juan, as tragic as it was, may pave the way for a way of life that will ensure the safety and care of all.
