

#### Silence and Solitude

Dear Parishioners:

Last week I had the privilege of participating in my annual retreat. This year I chose to spend my time away at the Abbey Genesee in New York - a monastery located about an hour outside of Rochester, NY. Nestled in the beautiful sloping valley of Genesee, the monastery is home to about 23 monks who have taken a solemn vow to live a life of prayer, work, community, solitude and contemplation. They are part of the world-wide Order of Cistercians of the Strict Observance, more commonly known as Trappists. They are dedicated to seeking union with God, through Jesus Christ, in a community of brothers.

Part of their rule is to also provide hospitality to people who wish to make a short or long retreat. Throughout the monastery walls accessible to the public and retreat house are the words "silence and solitude." In our day to day lives we are so inundated with noise and interruptions. I found the exterior silence so refreshing and fruitful for prayer. Entrance into the quiet of interior silence prepares one to commune with God in solitude. In solitude one is alone in conscious awakeness to God. In solitude one becomes absorbed and immersed in the immense and fruitful silence of God. According to Thomas Merton (1915-1968), Trappist Monk, solitude is a "country whose center is everywhere and whose circumference is nowhere. You do not find it by traveling but by standing still." (Seeds of Contemplation, 1949).

I hope and pray you find a few minutes of fruitful and prayerful silence and solitude in your busy lives.
