

Dear Friends,

This weekend as we celebrate the Solemnity of the



Body and Blood of Christ (Corpus Christi) we are mindful of the most incredible and awe inspiring Sacrament God could possibly give to us in the three dimensional dispensation in which we live. With the transubstantiation of bread and wine into the Body, Blood,

Soul and Divinity of our Lord Jesus Christ, God has literally thrown our experience of time aside as eternity breaks into time and draws time into eternity. Each week may we look forward to the Lord's day with anticipation as we receive again and again the awesome and transforming gift of heaven in the present moment.
