

# Ascension of the Lord



Dear Parishioners,

Today we celebrate the Solemnity of the Ascension of the Lord. This holy Solemnity, which the Acts of the Apostles 1:3 situates forty days after the Resurrection, commemorates Jesus' return to his Father in heaven. St. Augustine described the feast in the following manner. "Today our Lord Jesus Christ ascended into heaven: let our hearts ascend with him. Listen to the words of the Apostle: 'If you have risen with Christ, set your hearts on the things that are above where Christ is, seated at the right hand of God; seek the things that are above, not the things that are on earth.' For just as he remained with us even after his ascension, so we too are already in heaven with him, even though what is promised us has not yet been fulfilled in our bodies." On this World Day of Prayer for Communication associated with the Solemnity, we pray that our lives may communicate God's love and mercy and be a sign of hope to the world.

We also pray for those who work in the media: may they be honest and truthful in reporting the news, and may institutions and societies support the essential work that they do.
