

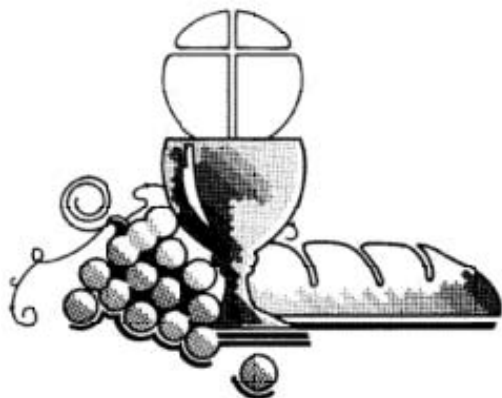

Dear Parishioners:

Today is the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ. Also known as Corpus Christi, today honours the body of Christ, both in the Eucharist and in the Church. Corpus Christi reminds us to stand with Christ, walk toward Him, and kneel in His holy presence.

When we receive the Eucharist, we become one Body in Christ. Standing together in Our Lord, we are united and as the Apostle Paul wrote, “Here there cannot be Greek and Jew, circumcised and uncircumcised, barbarian, Scythian, slave, free man, but Christ is all, and in all” (Col 3:11).

As we walk toward Christ, we grow in union with Him. In this way, we each play our individual role as the whole of the world gathers-in under His fold. As we kneel in adoration, we are choosing the freedom of Christ’s call over the slavery of man’s reign. In sacred silence, we come together and commune in the holy language of quietness. 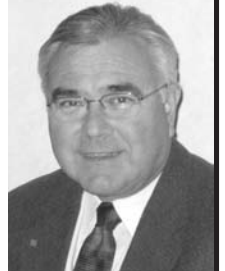
