

Share Lent Sunday

Dear Parishioners:

On Sunday, March 29 we will have our annual **Share Lent Sunday**. The Bishop of the Diocese of Hamilton, Most Rev. Douglas Crosby, OMI, has given his full support for the campaign organized by *Development and Peace – Caritas Canada*.

The theme for this year's Campaign is "*Our Common Home*". We are invited as Catholics to improve our relationship with God's Creation by connecting us to one of the Earth's most important ecosystems – the Amazon. This year's Campaign is in line with the recent Synod on the Pan-Amazon region. We know that the man-made environmental impact and deforestation are an existential threat not only to the people and living species there, but for the entire planet. The Amazon rainforest alone produces six percent of the world's oxygen and it readily absorbs large amounts of carbon dioxide from the atmosphere. The receding biosphere will only conflate the devastating impact of global warming.

By showing solidarity with the Amazonian communities we support their defense of the land and their effort to make sustainable choices for themselves and their children. Poverty is another harsh reality faced by the Amazonians. Even though there has been some progress, the Amazon region in Brazil, for example, has the highest rate of poverty in comparison to other regions in that country.

How can we help? Aside from advocating our government to show interest for the Amazonians, let us be generous in our offering for Share Lent Sunday. If you do not use regular envelopes, you can make a donation in an envelope marked "Share Lent". One of the Lenten practices is charity. We acknowledge the blessings we enjoy in this life and make a concerted effort to help those in need, not only locally but globally as well. Mindful of how we will be judged by the Lord in the way we treated "the least of our brothers and sisters" (Matthew 25), let us do what we can not only because it is morally right, but also because it is an integral part of who we are as followers of Jesus Christ.
