

Dear Parishioners:

As things continue to change rapidly, we have been instructed by the Bishop of Hamilton, His Excellency, Douglas Crosby, OMI, DD, to suspend all public Masses and gatherings. As a Priest for nearly 22 years, I could never have imagined this. However, we need to look out for each other. One great way is to pray. We need prayers more than ever. Also, check in with each other over the phone/email. While the Parish Office, Church and Hall will be closed (at least until April 7, 2020), we will still attend to all phone calls and emails. I will offer private Masses for your intentions and offer a private Mass for all of you on Sunday. The bulletins will be published, online and copies for those who want one. I can still see Parishioners, but by appointment only. Let us adhere to the instructions of our public health officials. Stay home if sick, do the necessary things and keep a safe distance. We will get through this. Also, please remember your continuing support for the Parish. Below is a special prayer that the Pope Francis offered:

O Mary, you always shine on our path as a sign of salvation and hope. We entrust ourselves to you, Health of the Sick, who at the cross took part in Jesus' pain, keeping your faith firm. You, Salvation of God's People, know what we need, and we are sure you will provide so that, as in Cana in Galilee, we may return to feasting after this time of trial.
