

Cancellation of Masses and Church Closure: During these unprecedented times and for the health and safety of all, the Bishop of the Diocese of Hamilton, His Excellency Douglas Crosby, has mandated that there be no public Masses until further notice, including funerals. We can do vigil prayers at the Funeral Home and burial service at the cemetery with the immediate family. Funeral Mass will take place later. In addition, the Church, Hall and Office will be closed to the public. That includes no private devotion and prayer in church. Please stay home and pray. I want to thank the few staff people who have come in to help with the essential upkeep of the Church. Thank you for your patience and understanding.

Confessions: Fr. Peter will listen to confessions. Please call ahead to book an appointment. In these extraordinary times, if you cannot get to a Priest, the Holy See (under the mandate of Pope Francis), instructed Catholics that one may receive general absolution or make a perfect act of contrition, until they are able to make a personal Confession. Remember, God is merciful!

Mass on TV/Web: You can watch the Mass at home. Vision TV: Sunday at 8 am; Monday to Friday, 8 am and 12 noon. Saturday, 8:00 am and 9:30 am. Salt & Light: Monday – Saturday, 6:30 am and 9:30 am with the Pope. 11:00 am, 3:00 pm and 10:30 pm; Sunday 10:00 am and 11:30 pm. You can also see the Mass anytime on the internet.

Masses offered by Fr. Peter: He will celebrate the daily Mass in private for your intentions and offer the Sunday Mass for all Parishioners, the sick, all the medical personnel attending to the sick and for an end to the COVID-19 pandemic. The Sunday Mass will be livestream ON Facebook, check "Blessed Sacrament Parish Hall Burford".
