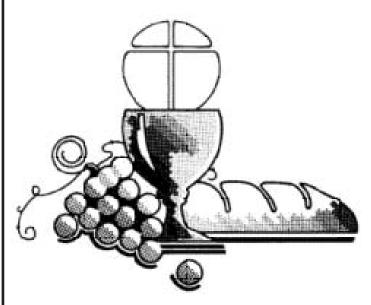

The Ascension of the Lord May 18th

Ascension Day often called Feast of the Ascension of Jesus Christ, Ascension Thursday and Holy Thursday is held on a Thursday 39 days (40th day of Easter) after Easter Sunday. The day commemorates Jesus Christ's ascension into heaven. He also gave the Great Commission, that all the world should be saved. In the first reading the ascension of Jesus is recounted and the Apostles are told they will receive the Holy Spirit. In the second reading we hear that Jesus Christ rules heaven and earth. And in the gospel, Jesus tells his disciples to preach the Good News to the whole world. Jesus left them with a command to be his witnesses, spreading the message of salvation to all around them. This command was not only for the disciples but for all believers throughout history, including us today. The Holy Spirit plays a central role in the Christian faith, empowering and guiding every believer. Jesus promised to send the Holy Spirit to his disciples, and he continues to guide and empower us today. The Holy Spirit is not limited to personal transformation, but also equips us to carry out God's mission in the world. It gives us the strength, wisdom, and gifts we need to serve others, proclaim the gospel message, and work for justice and peace. The promise of Christ's return is a central aspect of the Christian belief, bringing hope and joy to believers. Throughout the New Testament, Christ's return is described as a glorious event that will bring about the final judgment and the establishment of God's eternal kingdom. As believers, we eagerly anticipate Christ's return, knowing that our actions and choices in this life impact our eternal destiny.

8 Tips for Celebrating May, The Month of Mary

- **1. Put up an image of Mary:** You can decorate your home, your office or workplace with an altar, a statue, a painting, or any image of the Virgin Mary.
- **2. Read Bible passages:** You can read bible passages, such as, The Annunciation, The Birth of Jesus, The Presentation of Jesus in the Temple, and Mary at the foot of the Cross.
- **3. Pray the Rosary:** Praying the rosary is one of the main prayers of the church. Virgin Mary herself taught St. Dominic how to do it.
- **4. Participate in a Marian procession:** Marian processions are a tradition still alive in some countries. It involves walking with an image of Mary and saying Marian prayers and songs.
- **5. Receive the Sacraments:** Make sure you receive the Sacraments, especially confession and the Eucharist, where Jesus waits for us with open arms.
- **6. Perform the works of Mercy:** You can help a pregnant mother in need, or visit a nursing home, where you may find older women who feel lonely or abandoned.
- **7. Evangelize:** It is important to remind others how much the Virgin Mary loves them, and to teach them to pray to the Mother of God.
- 8. Give someone a Marian gift: It is recommended to give someone a Marian medal, or the Scapular of Our Lady of Mt. Carmel, blessed by a priest.
