

Dear Friends,

May is traditionally the Month of Mary. This year we cannot help but celebrate, as last week we celebrated the one hundredth anniversary of the first appearance of Our Lady to Lucia, Francesco and Jacinta. The latter two died as children and are the youngest non martyred children ever to be canonized. Lucia or Lucy lived into her nineties and the cause for her canonization has begun.

Pope Francis was very clear that these children were not canonized because they had a vision of Mary. They were canonized because they took their Christian Faith seriously and to heart. These children exhibited a prayer life and a love for God beyond that of most adults. The pope went so far as to call them mystics.

Jesus told us that we must become as little children if we are to be His followers. Let us pray for the grace to imitate St. Francesco and St. Jacinta in their fervour and love for God and the Most Blessed Mother. Let us pray to imitate Lucy in her constant faithfulness to God and Mary throughout her long life, never wavering and always willing to proclaim God's message.

We do not need visions to do as we ought. We have the Gospel, the teachings of Holy Church, and the witness of the saints. If a vision comes your way, be humble in the face of it. In the meanwhile let us strive to imitate these three children by living God's grace to the fullest. Whether canonized or not let us pray to be the Saints of God.
