




# IN THE DIOCESE OF HAMILTON AND AREA PARISHES & CHURCHES

Dear Friends,

In Canada, the Feast of the Ascension has been moved from Thursday to the nearest Sunday for quite awhile now. On the one hand the traditional day has been messed with. On the other hand our bishops want all of us to be aware of this special feast and to celebrate it.

Ascension Day is a watershed. Before this day the Risen Lord seemed to be appearing and being physically present to many, many people. But He has been very clear that He must go to the Father in order to send the Advocate, the Holy Spirit.

Although the Apostles, The Holy Women, and hundreds of others had seen Him and even touched Him and ate with Him, they could not quite comprehend what was happening. It was at Pentecost, a few days later, when the Holy Spirit entered the hearts of the Apostles and many disciples surrounding our Blessed Mother in the upper room that they finally got it. They knew the "facts" but the "facts" needed to be integrated into a seamless garment.

So it is that an unbeliever can read the Bible and the Catechism a hundred times without understanding. They can even memorize it and give lectures on Catholic teaching. But it is useless without the gift of Faith and the loving power of the Holy Spirit.

On this Feast of the Ascension let us begin praying for our unbelieving relatives, friends and neighbours to receive the Holy Spirit so they too can know the great gift of Pentecost.
